## **SUPPLY LIST for Pastel Artists**

**Pastels -** Bring what you normally work with. Make sure you have a good range of various hues, ranging from lightest to darkest darks. I advocate working with a modest selection of pastels, not every color ever made. <u>Do</u> make sure you have a nice selection of colorful darks, however, so that you aren't stuck using black every time you need to achieve a dark color.

## Surfaces

- Pastel Paper
  - A few large sheets of pastel paper or a number of smaller sheets
  - Some neutral grey, some white.
  - It doesn't have to be your best paper, but it needs to be able to take a few layers of pastel

## **Tools & Other Items**

- Grey Scale and Color Wheel
  - You can purchase these from Mainstreet. I want to be sure we are all using the same items. If you already own one or both of these, bring them in and I can tell you if they will work or not.
- Large Board to tape pastel paper to
- Making Tape
  - Must be neutral color, not blue
- Ruler 12" is long enough
- Paper Towels
