*This is a suggested supply list. Bring your regular paint supplies. A few new brushes may help for crisp edges and detail. **Please put your name on ALL of your supplies**, as we will be outside. Mainstreet sells most of the painting supplies needed.*

● **Plein Air Set-Up**

- **Easel** - French Easel or other outdoor easel - sturdy
- **Umbrella** - attaches to easel or goes right into the ground (ask Frankie)

● **Paints** - *these are recommended colors; any brand you like, except for where specified.*

- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Raw Sienna (Rembrandt only)
- Cadmium Orange
- Cadmium Red Light
- Alizarin Crimson
- Cerulean Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cobalt Blue
- Viridian Green
- Sap Green
- Burnt Sienna
- Burnt Umber
- Ivory Black
- Titanium White
- Thalo Red Rose (Grumbacher only)
- Dioxazine Purple
- Paynes Grey

● **Brushes** - *most of these are at Mainstreet*

- #2, #4, #6, #8, #10 collection of synthetic filberts and flats
- #2 flat sable (synthetic for small detail or signing)
- 1 long, thin rigger
- 1" & 2" wide cheap brushes with uneven hairs for washes



- **Surfaces**

- 6 - 8x10 stretched canvas or Raymar, Centurion, or SourceTek panels
  - Med tooth not smooth
  - if you are a more experienced plein air painter, you may work a little larger, but not larger than 11x14
- 8x10 canvas panel for demos

- **Sketching Materials**

- Sketchbook (approx 9x12 or smaller)
- Pencil
- Eraser

- **Other Items**

- Plexiglass palette
  - Brown paper backing or neutral color on back. No white paper palettes, please, they are too reflective
- Wet Canvas Carrier
  - Panel Pack or Raymar box is suggested
- 1" Masking Tape
- 1 Roll of **Viva** paper towels
- Small garbage bags to hang at your easel each day
- Camera
- Viewfinder (a must)
- Water (stay hydrated)
- 2 small spring clamps
- Pliers
- Hat with brim/visor
- Folding chair for lunch time
- Odorless Paint Thinner either Sunnyside or Gamsol
  - Medium sized jar with lid or your metal travel can; a metal tight container from Mainstreet is preferred.
  - These paint thinners are the most tolerable for painters, lowest odor and no allergic reactions.
